Pakistan an attractive place for 3G Mobile Operators

The policy for launching 3G services has already been submitted to the federal cabinet, and it is a matter of just few weeks to auction 3G spectrum, reported in an interview by Hafeezur Rehman, Federal Secretary for Information Technology and Telecom.

He said despite the global recession and a worrying security situation the government wants the 3G services to be available for the Pakistani cellular customers. The policy decision whether the existing operators only will be allowed to participate or more international companies will be invited will be decided by the cabinet. He said the policy in this regard will not be discriminating for existing companies or new entrants.

Meanwhile the Country Director, Nokia Siemens Networks Pakistan has said that despite economic recession, Pakistan is an attractive place to adopt 3G for mobile operators as it would support the economic growth of Pakistan & meet the new needs for data services. 3G is the most logical answer because it delivers the lowest cost per bit.

Rs.04 billion revenue earned by Cellular operators in Pakistan

Cellular mobile operators in Pakistan have earned Rs.104.090 billion revenue during the first half (July-December) of the current financial year 2008-09. According to Telecom Quarterly Review (TQR) released by Pakistan Telecommunication Authority (PTA), investment worth \$833.2 million was made by these cellular operators during the first half (July-December) of the current financial year. Total investment made during the second quarter (October-December 08) was \$511 million.

The mobile market revenues have turned out to be satisfactory during the second quarter period with total revenue amounting to Rs.54 billion. The companies although suffered lower profits during the 2nd and 3rd quarter of 2008, however, the year ended with much stability and growth in the industry's total revenue.

According to independent analyst firm Research and Markets Report "Pakistan Mobile forecast 2008-10, the ARPU (Average Revenue Per User) of Pakistan mobile industry would continue to see reductions in ARPUs over the forecast period of 2008-2010.

In 2010, it forecasts that Pakistan will have the average ARPU level of \$2.66, however, the country would keep increasing the penetration levels and would become most highly penetrated market in South Asia." Review said.

He also said that IBA Karachi had already signed a Memorandum of Understanding (MoU) with their organisation to include SAP courses in its curriculum for MBA students.
